[Emmanuel Music's](#) 40th anniversary season continues with the first of four concerts focusing on the chamber and vocal music of **Beethoven** at 4pm on October 31st at Emmanuel Church.

This year, under the direction of newly appointed Artistic Director [Ryan Turner](#), Emmanuel Music embarks on a multi-year journey surveying the chamber and vocal music of **Beethoven**. From the early Opus 1 piano trios, to rarely performed

chamber music for winds, to the soaring melody and passion of Beethoven's vocal music, this series presents the breadth of emotion, talent and artistry of the Emmanuel musicians. This series continues the great Emmanuel Music tradition of acclaimed surveys of Brahms, Schubert, Schumann, and others.

This inaugural concert of the series marks the return of long-time Emmanuel music pianist **Judith Gordon**. Ms. Gordon was named Boston Globe Musician of the year in 1996 and has been presented in recital frequently by the Boston Celebrity Series and participated in Emmanuel Music's multi-season series of music by Schubert, Schumann, and Harbison.

The Emmanuel Music ensemble for this evening's concert will also feature [Zachary Wilder](#), *tenor*; [Rose Drucker](#), *violin*; Jonina Mazzeo, *viola*; and [Michael Curry](#), *cello*.

This first concert will present early, relatively unfamiliar songs: *Piano Trio No. 1 in Eb*, op. 1; *Six Gellert Songs*, op. 48; *String Trio No. 1 in Eb*, op. 3.
